- ✓ Make his fur look soft and fluffy?
- ✓ Get his nose to look the same colour?
- ✓ Draw in all of the green plants?
- ✓ Capture the texture of the wooden log he's standing next to?
- ✓ Draw in all the small detail like the bits of shell in the concrete?
- ✓ Draw in all his whiskers?
- ✓ Get the shades of grey exactly the same as in the picture?
- ✓ See how the tip of his tail folds over - can you draw this in to?

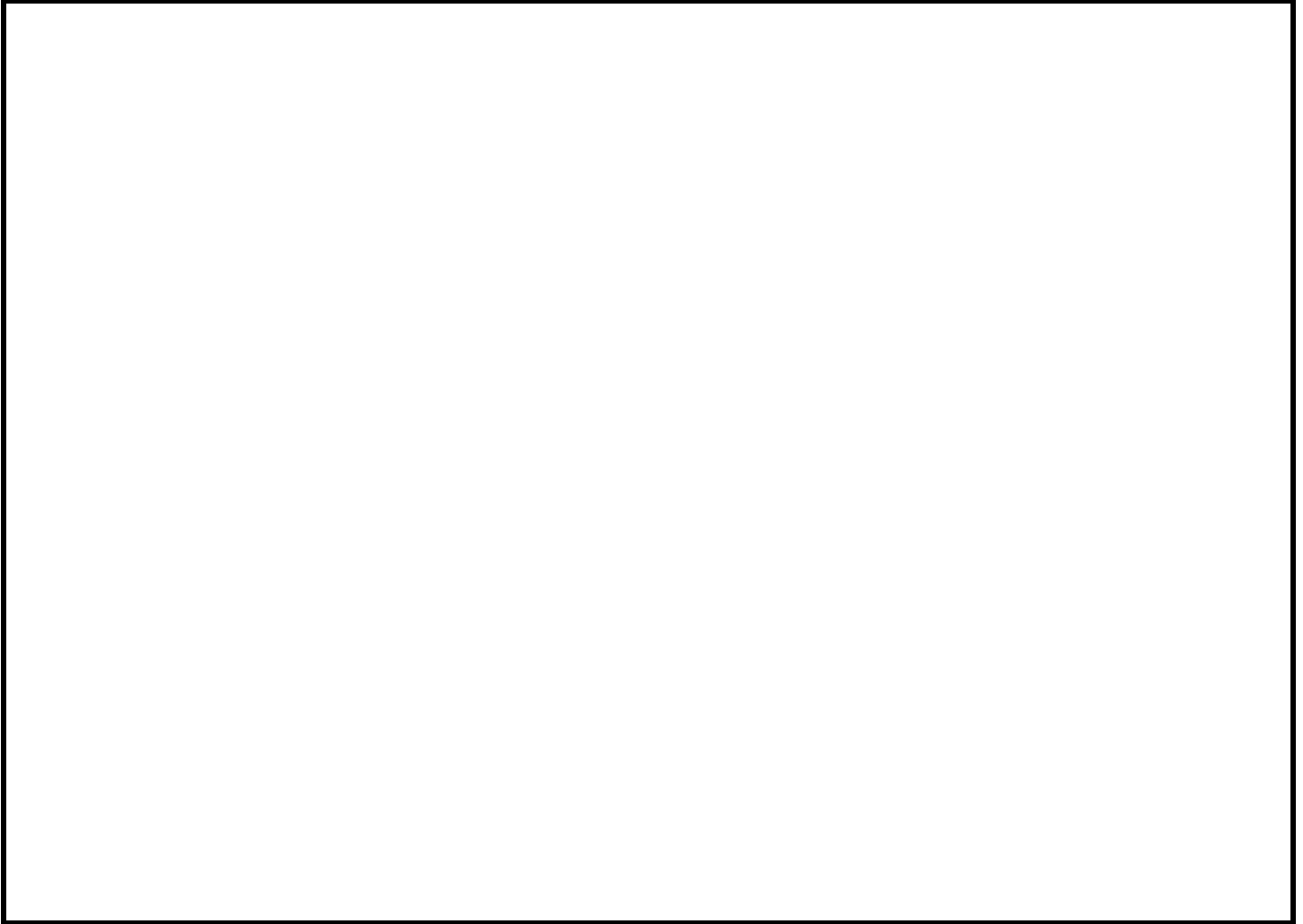
Try this - Get a ruler & Pencil.
