You can open your door to a career in sport from any level. If you don't have any qualifications, and are not sure where to start, a Foundation programme will suit you.

If you're more experienced, and have some runs on the board Level 3 and 4 will set you on a path. More experience again and direction, then try Level 5 and 6, leading to further Tertiary study to meet your needs.

Our Auckland, Wellington, Hamilton and Christchurch sites each offer a broad range of qualifications relevant to the Sport, Fitness and Recreation industries along with experienced and knowledgeable teaching staff.

Tertiary Programmes and Degree Options

Our Diploma Level 5 programme, the NZIS Diploma in Sport Management and Exercise Science, ensures that students have explored all aspects of the industry in preparation for higher-level Diploma and Degree studies.

After successfully graduating from this Level 5 programme, students can choose to proceed to higher learning and go either in the direction of Advanced Sport Management or Advanced Exercise Prescription.

After finishing one of these Level 6 programmes, students will be well equipped to start their career in the Sport, Fitness and Recreation industries.



Do you supply accommodation for students?

Does NZIS offer financial assistance?

This means that all of our full-time students are eligible for student loans and allowances, except for Zero fees Youth Guarantee students (who are not eligible for loans but who may be eligible for allowances). Are there scholarships available?

Each year NZIS offers a selected number of part or full tuition fee scholarships across our four campuses.

- Scholarships are awarded on the following criteria:
- Academic Achievement – Exceptional Academic Record
- Sporting Achievement – Representative level in one or more sports
- Club/Community Contribution – Commitment to Club and/or community events
- Financial hardship - For those who otherwise wouldn't have an opportunity to study.

What are the Youth Guarantee / Zero Fees Programmes?

You may be eligible for our Zero fees youth Guarantee Programme (please note as the programme is fully funded, it is not eligible for student loans and allowances).

To qualify students must meet the following criteria:

- 16 to 19 years of age at the start of programme (if the candidate is 15 years, an exemption letter from Ministry of Education is required)
- A commitment to completing the full year of study
- A passion for sport and motivation for learning
- You may also qualify for assistance for your travel needs. This can be discussed in more detail during your interview as a number of factors will need to be considered.
